



Language Coaching

Applying coaching techniques to the client's learning project in order to allow the client to become freer, more autonomous and as confident as possible



Training..... Coaching ...

- Courses or lessons
- Teach: explain, train, encourage
- Trainer supplies content
- Evaluation of level
- Objective = progress

- Coaching sessions
- Accompany: support, make do, provide feedback
- Client supplies request
- Feedback on progress
- Objective = autonomy



Q2: What's important about the 4 key aspects of coaching (stance, alliance, activities, motivation)?




The coach's stance (la posture)


